## Summer League for swimmers in the Senior, Senior 2 and Junior groups

- The schedule is set up so that kids can participate in summer league
- IF THEY CHOOSE TO PARTICIPATE the kids do not have to if they do not want to
- This in no way can get in the way of normal training ex "Sorry Coach, missed morning practice because the summer league meet ran late"

AG and Developmental swimmers are encouraged to stay with Baylor in the summer for practices if possible.

Juniors, Senior 2 and Senior group swimmers are expected to attend all scheduled practices

## Summer Fees

The fees for the summer will remain the same as they are during the school year. The developmental group is having a mini session in May that will be \$67 and \$77 for the 2day/3 day option. All members will be automatically enrolled in the May session unless you have already emailed Laura. Swimmers that were in the Upper School or Lower School groups during the school year will be moved to the Senior or Junior groups and pay those fees for June and July.

Please refrain from coaching your child from the stands at practice, at home and at meets. As parents, your role is to take care of their basic needs and encourage them. Please leave the coaching up to his or her coach.

Questions about meet events and technique should be addressed before or after practices with the coach. If you need to get a message to your child's coach you may email them thru their baylorswimming.org account or you may contact the office and we will forward the message.
