

Baylor Swimming Lesson Policies and Release

Please read and agree to the following.

- REGISTRATION FEE: There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$30/swimmer/year, payable at time of registration. This is a one-time fee/year <u>Your registration is not complete until the registration fee is paid.</u>
- MAKE-UP POLICY: WE DO NOT OFFER MAKE-UPS for illness, conflicts with other activities, or vacations
- CANCELLATION POLICY: To cancel a class you must withdraw at least THREE DAYS prior to the beginning of the class. If you withdraw from a class, you will receive a refund for the class.
- SCHEDULE CHANGE POLICY: Schedule changes are subject to class/session availability. All
 changes must be made at least THREE DAYS prior to scheduled session. Please choose
 classes carefully.
- ILLNESS POLICY: If your child is absent from class due to illness for THREE CONSECUTIVE CLASSES a refund will be issued for the missed classes. <u>A refund will NOT be issued without a note from the doctor.</u> The note must have the dates that the child was not allowed to be in class. The refund will be \$12.50 per class (Beg. & Adv Beg) and \$17.00 (pre-swim team).
 - If an instructor is unable to teach a swimming lesson due to illness it is possible that the lesson could be postponed. If this is the case, then a make-up date will be scheduled for the missed lesson(s).
- CREDITS: Baylor Swim Lesson credits may be applied toward future swim lessons, group or
 private. Baylor Swim Lesson credits may not be applied towards swim team dues or entry fees,
 unless that child is moving from lessons to swim team. Credits will not be replaced if lost or
 stolen. Credits are not transferable. Credits are NOT redeemable for cash
- POOL CLOSINGS: The teaching pool will be closed for the following reasons:
 When a child vomits or has a bowel movement in the pool, the pool must be closed for sanitation.

Inclement weather - If Baylor School is closed due to bad weather there will not be any swimming lessons. If Baylor closes early during the school day due to bad weather all swimming lessons will be cancelled for that day.

If conditions in the pool make it unsafe for students to be in the pool, the pool will be closed.

BAYLOR SCHOOL NATATORIUM: A make-up class will be scheduled.

- POOL CLOSING FEE: If your child vomits or has a bowel movement in the pool thereby causing the pool to be closed, you will be assessed a fee of \$100.00. Your child will not be allowed to participate in class until the fee is paid.
- SEATING FOR PARENTS AND SIBLINGS: Parents and siblings of swim lesson students that
 wish to stay in the building during lessons must sit in the stands up above the pool or
 remain in the pool lobby. Parents will be allowed in the teaching pool room during the
 first 5 minutes and last 5 minutes of the lesson
