This meet will be conducted under the auspices of Southeastern Swimming, Inc. of USA Swimming. USA Swimming technical rules and regulations will be followed with the exception of specifically addressed in the meet information sanctioned by Southeastern Swimming, Inc.

Baylor Swim Club has taken enhanced health and safety measures for your team and guests. You must follow all posted instructions of this facility under the guidelines from the Hamilton County Health Department while attending this event.

### **Facility:**

The Baylor School offers a 10-lane, 25 yard competition pool, with a 7 ft minimum depth, non-turbulent lane lines, a fully automatic electronic timing system, and a scoreboard with lane, time/place display. The competition pool has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of the certification is on file with USA Swimming.

### **Rules and Notes:**

- Unless otherwise noted herein, this meet shall be conducted in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations
- Please note that use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Changing into or out of swimsuits on deck is prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) anytime athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with the requirement.
- All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of the competition.
- Effective September 1, 2020: The swimmer must wear only one swimsuit in one of two pieces, except as provided in 205.10.1. all swimsuits shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee. No technical suits shall be worn by any 12 & under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any sanctioned, approved, or observed meet. Please see USA Swimming Rules note-102.8 F
- In the interest of safety and accident prevention, coaches, officials and swimmers are asked to observe all posted rules and to conduct themselves in a safe manner. Only coaches, swimmers, officials, and volunteers are allowed on the pool deck.
- Per SES rules, coaches shall display, when requested, their USAS Membership cards to be allowed on deck at any SES sanctioned meet. All coaches are required to sign in at the Coaches Check In table and all coaches must be prepared to show their coaching credentials ( coaches card/deck pass) at any time to the Meet Director and/or the Meet Referee.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All participants must be currently USA Swimming registered athletes. Entries will not be accepted without USA registration numbers. Coaches and officials must present evidence of certification as required by Southeastern Swimming. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine his or her age for the entire meet. **There will be NO on-deck USA Swimming membership registration at the meet.**

**WARM UP:** USA and SES warm-up guidelines will be in effect. Each group will be assigned warm up lanes and times

**DISABILITIES:** Swimmers with disabilities are welcome and must complete the Information Form for Disabled Swimmers and return it with the entries.

**DEADLINE:** Coaches must have entries completed by February 19, 2021

**FEES:** There is a \$25 flat fee for entry into the meet. This includes a \$4 SES charge.

**LIMITS:** 11-12 and Senior swimmers are limited to 8 individual events for the meet and no more than 4 per day. 10&Under swimmers are allowed a total of 6 events and no more than 3 per day.

**MEET FORMAT:** This is a time final meet. All events will be pre-seeded. All events will be swum as mixed gender events.

**OFFICIALS' CORNER:** All officials planning on being at the meet and working some or all sessions should contact the Meet Referee. Officials are to enter the pool through the double red doors. Entry will be allowed 20 minutes prior to the competition starting.
