



## **Baylor Swimming Lesson COVID-19 Safety Protocols & Procedures**

### **Preparing to Swim**

- Temperatures of all swimming lesson participants will be taken as they enter the natatorium. Anyone with a fever of 100.4°F, or higher, will not be able to enter the facility. It is advised that you take your temperature before heading to campus.
- Please **DO NOT** bring students to a swimming lesson class if they are sick. We ask that parents please contact the Swim School Director ([bgill@baylorschool.org](mailto:bgill@baylorschool.org)) if the student is sick and will not be able to make it to the swimming lesson.
- Drop off for swimming lesson participants will take place at red double door at the back of the natatorium. (There are signs that say “swimming lesson drop-off / pick-up”)
- Parents will NOT be able to enter the facility with participants, however there will be chairs set up outside the red double doors at the rear of the natatorium for parents to wait until the conclusion of the lessons. Parents may also wait in their car for the duration of the lesson. If weather permits, doors will be propped so that parents can see into the teaching pool room.
- There will be a scheduled 5 min. window between swimming lessons for participants to exit the pool before the start of the next lesson.
- Swimming lesson participants should come to the lesson in their suit and then exit the pool / facility in their suit. Items to bring should include: personal face mask, towel, goggles (if they want them). No other items should come in the facility. Personal face masks are required when entering and exiting the natatorium.
- The Baylor School requires the wearing of masks at all times while on campus including outside areas.



## **During Lessons**

- Bathrooms are to be used for emergencies ONLY. Locker rooms are NOT available for changing before or after swimming lessons. Please make every effort to have your child(ren) use the restroom prior to arriving at the pool for lessons.
- Swimming lesson participants may NOT share any equipment. Kick boards will be available for use during the lesson, and then cleaned thoroughly so they can be used for the next swimming lesson. Lost and found goggles will NOT be available for use by swimming lesson participants.
- Swimming lesson instructors will be wearing a face shield while in the water with swimming lesson students. If an instructor is out of the water teaching, then they will be wearing a mask during the lesson.
- Coaches & aquatics staff will be in masks during their time at the pool.
- CDC guidelines requiring all people to remain at least 6 ft. away from each other will be enforced.

## **After Swimming**

- Once the lesson is over swimming lesson participants will gather their belongings and immediately exit through the red double doors of the teaching pool room one at a time. Doors will be propped open and monitored.
- Parents should wait for swimming lesson participant to come to them. If parents have left the pool please be on time to pick them up. Wash your hands thoroughly or use hand sanitizer after leaving the pool.
- Shower at home; wear your suit to and from the swimming lesson.
