

Baylor PRIVATE Swimming Lesson Policies and Release

Please read and agree to the following.

- PRIVATE SWIMMING LESSON FEES: Private lesson: 31.00 for 30 min. | Semi-private lesson: \$47.00 for 30 min.
- CANCELLATION POLICY: To cancel a lesson you must contact either the Swim School Director (bgill@baylorschool.org | pool office: 423-267-8506 x630) or the instructor directly within 24 hours of the scheduled lesson.
- SCHEDULE CHANGE POLICY: Schedule changes should be made by contacting the Swim School Director (bgill@baylorschool.org | pool office: 423-267-8506 x630). All changes must be made at least 24 hours before the scheduled lesson.
- MISSING A SCHEDULED LESSON: If for some reason you miss a scheduled lesson without contacting the Swim School Director or instructor, a refund for the lesson will <u>NOT</u> be issued.
- ILLNESS POLICY: ILLNESS POLICY: If your child is sick and cannot make the scheduled lesson please either contact the Swim School Director (bgill@baylorschool.org | pool office: 423-267-8506 x630) or the instructor directly. A refund for the lesson may be issued if you contact the Swim School Director at least 24 hours ahead of the scheduled lesson.

If an instructor is unable to teach a swimming lesson due to illness it is possible that the lesson could be postponed. If this is the case, then a make-up date will be scheduled for the missed lesson(s).

POOL CLOSINGS: The teaching pool will be closed for the following reasons: When a child vomits or has a bowel movement in the pool, the pool must be closed for sanitation.

Inclement weather - If Baylor School is closed due to bad weather there will not be any swimming lessons. If Baylor closes early during the school day due to bad weather all swimming lessons will be cancelled for that day.

If conditions in the pool make it unsafe for students to be in the pool, the pool will be closed.

BAYLOR SCHOOL NATATORIUM: A make-up class will be scheduled.

- POOL CLOSING FEE: If your child vomits or has a bowel movement in the pool thereby causing the pool to be closed, you will be assessed a fee of \$100.00. Your child will not be allowed to participate in class until the fee is paid.
- SEATING FOR PARENTS AND SIBLINGS: Parents and siblings of swim lesson students that
 wish to stay in the building during lessons must sit in the stands up above the pool or
 remain in the pool lobby. Parents will be allowed in the teaching pool room during the
 first 5 minutes and last 5 minutes of the lesson
