

ELIGIBILITY FOR TIME RECOGNITION TO THE SWIMS DATABASE	<p>Effective September 1, 2022, there will NO longer be a 30-day administrative grace period. Going forward, ANY 17-year-old athlete who has not completed the APT requirements by their 18th birthday WILL NOT be a USA Swimming member in good standing unless or until the APT requirement is completed. This includes eligibility to compete in USA Swimming sanctioned meets, club practices and all other related activities. Athletes will continue to receive an email notification reminder of the APT requirement 30 days prior to their 18th birthday as well as a reminder on their 18th birthday. ALL I+USA Swimming members aged 18 years old and older are required to complete APT annually. This is the individual's responsibility and includes both athlete and non-athlete members.</p>

FACILITY:	<p>Georgia Tech- McAuley Aquatic Center 750 Ferst Drive Atlanta, GA 30332</p> <p>The site of the 1996 Olympic Swimming Venue seats 1,950 spectators and includes a competition pool and dive pool. The competition pool is 50 meters by 10 lanes, with two movable bulkheads so that courses can be set up for 25 yards or 50 meters. The pool also features built in Omega timing with reaction timed starting blocks. The dive pool will be monitored and used for warm-up and warm-down during the competition.</p> <p>We will use two 10 lane courses for preliminary sessions (split by gender) and one 10 lane course for finals sessions.</p> <p>The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) and a copy of such certification is on file with Georgia Swimming and USA Swimming.</p>																		
MEDICAL SUPERVISION:	<p>Lifeguards will be on duty during the course of the meet. Paramedics will also be stationed in the facility.</p> <p>Portable oxygen tanks and an AED are available in case of emergencies.</p>

- o 13 & Over 1650 Free is a deck seeded timed final event, swum in the preliminary session fastest to slowest. The fastest seeded heat will swim in Finals. Swimmers entered in the 1650 Free may indicate if they are available to swim only in the AM session by marking “AM” next to their initials at positive check in.
- o 13-14 400 IM and 500 Free will swim only an A Final.
- o Senior 400 IM and 500 Free will swim only an A and B Final.

RELAY EVENTS:

- 10&U Relays will be swum in the preliminary sessions, heats swum slowest to fastest.
- 11-12, 13-14, Senior, and Open relays will be swum in the final’s sessions.
- 11-12 Relays will be swum fastest to slowest in each event.
- 13-14, Senior & Open relays will be swum fastest heat of Girls, then fastest heat of Boys, then alternate girls/boys fastest to slowest.
- **Teams are limited to two relay entries in each relay event**
- 10&U Relay cards must be submitted to the Clerk of Course by the START of the PRELIMINARY session on the day of the event.
- Open 200 Free Relay and Open 200 Medley Relay cards must be submitted to the Clerk of Course by the COMPLETION of the PRELIMINARY session the day of the event.
- **All other 11-12, 13-14, Senior relay cards must be submitted to Clerk of Course by 4:00 p.m. the day of the event.**
- Relay cards must have each swimmer’s first and last names and must be presented in the order in which the swimmers are to swim in the relay.
- The meet hosts reserve the right to split the relay heats and swim them in 2 courses during the preliminary and/or finals sessions.

FINALS SESSIONS: Finals will be swum in a single 10 lane course as follows:

- 11-12 age group – A Final
- 13-14 age group – B and A Finals
 - o 13-14 age group - A Final only for 400 IM and 500 Free
- Senior age group – C, B, and A Finals for events 200 and down
 - o Senior age group – B and A Finals for 400 IM and 500 Free
- *Event alternate swimmers must also report to the starting area. Alternate swimmers may be placed in any heat as exhibition athletes (non-scoring).*

SEEDING:

- Preliminary Sessions- Sessions will be seeded after the scratch box closes (see section below).
 - o Heats will run slowest seeded to fastest seeded. The fastest three (3) heats will be circle seeded
 - o Entries will be ranked in this order: SCY qualifiers, non-conforming qualifiers (LCM/SCM), and bonus qualifiers.
- Finals Exceptions:
 - o The fastest two (2) heats of each of the 13-14 and Senior 500 Free & 400 IM will be circle seeded.

- o The 13&Over 1650 Free will be swum fastest to slowest at the conclusion of the preliminary session, with the fastest heat being swum at finals.

SCRATCHES:

- Scratch Box- This competition will follow the scratch rules as defined in section 207.11.6 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.
 - o Day 1 Events: Scratch Box closes at 5:30PM on February 29. Scratches will be submitted to meetdirector@dynamoswimclub.com
 - o Day 2-3 Events: All subsequent day's scratches are due 30 minutes after the start of the previous evening's finals. Scratch Box will be at the Clerk of Course table
 - o DFS athletes if they do not intend to swim an event after the scratch box closes
- Finals-
 - o Any swimmer qualifying for a bonus, consolation, or championship Final in an individual event who fails to compete in said final shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. A declared false start under 101.1.3E or deliberate delay of meet under 101.1.5 is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.
 - o In the event of withdrawal or barring a swimmer from competition the Referee shall fill the bonus, consolation, or championship final, when possible, with the next qualified swimmer(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the Finals.
 - o Where bonus and consolation Finals have not been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known to the Referee, the Referee shall reseed the bonus, consolation, and championship final, if necessary, to insert the alternate(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in the final.
 - o If the bonus and consolation Finals have already been contested, the championship Final shall be swum with an available alternate, (Exhibition)
 - o Exceptions for failure to compete — No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if:
 - The Referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.
 - A swimmer qualifying for a bonus, consolation or championship Final based upon the results of the preliminaries notifies the Referee within thirty (30) minutes after announcement of the qualifiers for that race that they may not intend to compete and further declares their final intentions within thirty (30) minutes following their last individual preliminary event.
 - It is determined by the Referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

FLIGHTED PRELIMINARIES: Based on the number of entries, the 400 IM and 500 Free

All 2024 swimmers registered with USA Swimming and/or their respective World Aquatics Federation, in good standing with their local national federation, will be allowed to compete.</p> <p>All foreign delegations must submit documentation from their federation indicating athletes, coaches, and team support are members in good standing of their World Aquatics affiliated federation. “Host Club” will not allow unregistered swimmers, coaches, officials, or teams to participate in this meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.</p>

RULES:	<p>Current USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet.</p> <p>Tech Suit Restrictions for 12-and-Under Swimmers (Note: WOVEN FABRIC-A suit with woven fabric and sewn seams that does not extend below the hips is permitted.)</p>

(Note: KNIT FABRIC-A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams not extending below the knees is permitted.)

This rule is in effect for all USA Swimming competitions in the United States, so any manufacturer or vendor selling a suit in the United States is subject to the above rule. No Technical Suits may be worn by any 12-Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, behind the blocks (Including warm-up, warm-down, and Competition), rest rooms or locker rooms.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Deck changes are prohibited. (Defined as changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes). Swimmers participating in deck changing could be subject to removal from further competition in the meet.

On deck registrations will not be permitted during this event.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coaches' areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair, Program & Events Committee Chair, or designee.

All referees, starters, administrative officials, chief judges, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity in a sanctioned event, must be non-athlete members of USA Swimming or members of other World Aquatics-member organizations. All meet directors for meets sanctioned by USA Swimming must be members of USA Swimming. Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity in a sanctioned event must be coach members of USA Swimming.

Photos and videos may be taken of swimmers during the meet by parents or a professional photographer retained by the host club. All participants agree to be filmed or photographed by photographers designated by the meet host and to allow the meet host the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during, or after the period of participation in Georgia Swimming competitions to promote swimming and meets hosted by the meet organizer. If you do not wish to have your child(ren) photographed, you may withdraw your consent by informing the Meet Director before the start of the first day of the meet.

Swimmers participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy must be under the supervision of their own coach or a USA Swimming member coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in deciding for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

USA SWIMMING MEMBER VERIFICATION:	As of September 2022, Deck Pass and Deck Pass Plus are no longer available. To access USA Swimming member benefits, including your USA Swimming member card, download the USA Swimming app. Present this card to verify your USA-S and GA LSC credentials are in good standing.
COACHES: COACHES MEETING:	Coaches will be required to sign in at the Clerk of Course desk to verify their credentials, via SWIMS 3.0, are in good standing with USA-S and their respective LSC. A coaches' meeting will be held via Zoom on Tuesday, February 27 at 8:30pm EST. Zoom information will be sent the day of the meeting.
OFFICIALS:	“Host Club” welcomes visiting officials and apprentices and will appreciate help in officiating this competition. Certified Officials or Apprentices wishing to work this meet may contact the Meet Referee: Ed Saltzman/ swimsalt@bellsouth.net There will be an official’s meeting 45 minutes prior to the start of each session. The official’s uniform will consist of a white polo collared shirt, navy blue shorts, skirts or slacks with white socks and white shoes. All officials must present at check in, their current LSC Officials Certification Card; OR a recently completed Apprentice Form; AND proof of current USA Swimming Non-Athlete membership. Credentials may be required for deck access and hospitality.
MEET COMMITTEE / MEET JURY:	The Meet Committee / Meet Jury shall be established during the coaching meeting or prior to the competition and shall consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, 2 Coaches, and 1 athlete member, as appropriate. As defined in the Official Glossary (2023 USA Swimming Rulebook)
