Registration

To register with Baylor Swim and Dive Club, complete the online registration on www.baylorswimming.org. **Returning member** online registration opens on **Wednesday August 6th**, while **new member** registration opens on **Friday, August 15th**. The online registration and payment must be received before the swimmer can participate. The registration fee includes a Baylor Swim Club cap and T-shirt. USA Swimming Registration is \$82.00, and swim club registration is \$70.00. The club registration for a second child is \$50.00.

Dues

All practice groups are billed monthly on the <u>first</u> day of the month. Bills are emailed on the first day of each month. They are to be paid by the 20th of each month. Swimmers will be withheld from participation if the account becomes more than 30 days past due. If you are going to be out of town or missing for a month we must be notified in writing no later than the 5th of the month prior to when you will be out in order for your account to be credited. For example: if you will be out in November the email must be received by October 5. ALL FEES AND DUES MUST BE PAID ONLINE.

USA Swimming registration is now separate from the club registration. Once your Baylor Swim Club registration is complete you will receive a link to register with USA Swimming (\$82). USA Swimming membership is required for ALL members. If you are a returning member of Baylor Swim Club, the club will handle the renewal of your swimmer's USA Swimming membership.

AAU Diving Registration is separate from the club registration. AAU membership is required for all divers

Meet Entry Fees

Meet entry fees are separate from your monthly dues. Meet fees are included in your monthly bill statement if your child was entered in the swim meet. Remember once the scratch deadline has passed you are required to pay the entry fees even if the child does not attend the meet.

Volunteer Opportunities

Baylor Swim and Dive Club will host five swim meets and 2 dive meets during the 2025-2026 season. These meets are staffed by our family volunteers, and allow for the club to not require any parental fundraising. Baylor Swim and Dive Club has the reputation of running high quality meets and providing a great hospitality menu. In order to run things smoothly it takes all of our parents working in some capacity at the meets. Due to the importance of the financial impact of meets on our club there is a \$40 persession fee for families that do not meet the volunteer requirement for each meet. Volunteer sign-up for meets is done online and there are many choices of places and times to volunteer.

Volunteering is required for all families with swimmers in the Developmental groups through the Senior group. Due to the swim meets we host, there is a \$100.00 hospitality fee per year per family. This fee will be billed the month following your registration. This fee allows the club to provide food and drinks for coaches and officials during the meets, and keeps parents from having to supply these items. Families with children in the Developmental-WHITE group through the Senior group are expected to volunteer at all hosted meets regardless of whether or not your child participates in the meet. Diving families are required to volunteer at each of the home hosted dive meets. Diving families will not be charged the hospitality fee as they will be required to help provide food items at meets.
